The winning team in the Final Competition of the sixth YAP, called Sei Gor's 3,000 Delicacies, designed a game business for Broadway Macau™ which combines culinary offerings with virtual reality and augmented reality to provide an unprecedented entertainment experience to the customer. GEG also sponsored the winning team and the winners of the Outstanding & Loyalty Award for a seven-day Asian City Study Tour in Seoul, South Korea, where the group visited Asia's first Google Campus, the Seoul Global Startup Center and the Korea Exchange, during which they met with the experts and entrepreneurs to discuss their ideas and experiences with entrepreneurship.

GEG and MMA recognized the achievement of the outstanding YAP members by awarding prizes including the YAP Ambassador Award, the YAP Happy Moment Video Award, the Best Marketing Planner Award, the Outstanding & Loyalty Award and the award for the Final Competition.
